## What if I reported a bully, but no one listened?

If you've been bullied, and this is the first time you've said anything about it, its possible the people you told don't realize how big the problem is. Every time a bullying incident occurs, it needs to be reported. If nothing happened the first time you reported bullying, don't stop.

Keep speaking up and telling someone about the problem, because obviously it hasn't just gone away on its own. Tell a couple of different people if you have to, people that you trust and know will listen to you.

So who can you tell? What if you can't tell your parents? Maybe you can tell your grand-mother? Your aunt or uncle? What about your babysitter, the principle, the guidance counselor, your school librarian or nurse, your godparents.

Tell a trusted adult what is going on. Don't be discouraged if nothing happens after the third of fourth time you tell.

Keep telling, because the loudest complaints get the most attention.
